**VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:** If you would like to volunteer your time to support the Marines and families of 2/6 we have the following opportunities available:

### Family Readiness Assistant

Position Description: Supports the Family Readiness Program, welcomes new family members to unit, provides feedback to Family Readiness Officer from unit families, and assists with information and referral services. Family Readiness Assistants cannot serve as Morale Support Volunteers.

Requirements:

- Should be spouse and/or a parent/extended family member of the unit
- Is appointed in writing by the Commanding Officer
- Must complete training within 30 days of appointment
- 1-year commitment
- Is bound by confidentiality guidelines

*\*\*We are currently seeking Family Readiness Assistants that speak foreign languages\*\**

### Support Volunteer

Position Description: Assists the Family Readiness Officer with unit morale support events such as family days, beach bashes, meet & greets and holiday parties. This includes the planning, organization and execution of those events. Support Volunteers cannot serve as Family Readiness Assistants.

Requirements:

- Ideally a spouse or parent/extended family that is geographically located near Camp Lejeune
- Will serve on a "per event" basis

- Is not required to attend training
- Will not be appointed by the Commanding Officer
- No long-term commitment
